

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

“As I was before the Blessed Sacrament on a day during the Octave of Corpus Christi, 1675 [probably Sunday, June 16th], I received from God most special graces of His love. I felt moved with the desire of making Him some return and giving Him love for love, and He said to me: ‘Thou canst not make Me a more acceptable return of love than by doing what I have so often asked of thee!’ Then, showing me His Divine Heart, He said: ‘Behold this Heart which has so loved men that It has spared nothing, even to exhausting and consuming Itself to prove to them Its love. In return, I receive from the greater number nothing but ingratitude, contempt, irreverence, sacrilege, and coldness in this Sacrament of My love. But what I feel still more is that there are hearts consecrated to Me who use Me thus. Therefore I ask of thee that the first Friday after the Octave of the Feast of the Blessed Sacrament shall be kept as a special Festival in honor of My Heart, to make reparation for all the indignities offered to It, and as a Communion day, in order to atone for the unworthy treatment It has received when exposed upon the altars. I also promise that My Heart shall shed in abundance the influence of Its divine love on all those who shall thus honor It or cause It to be so honored.’”

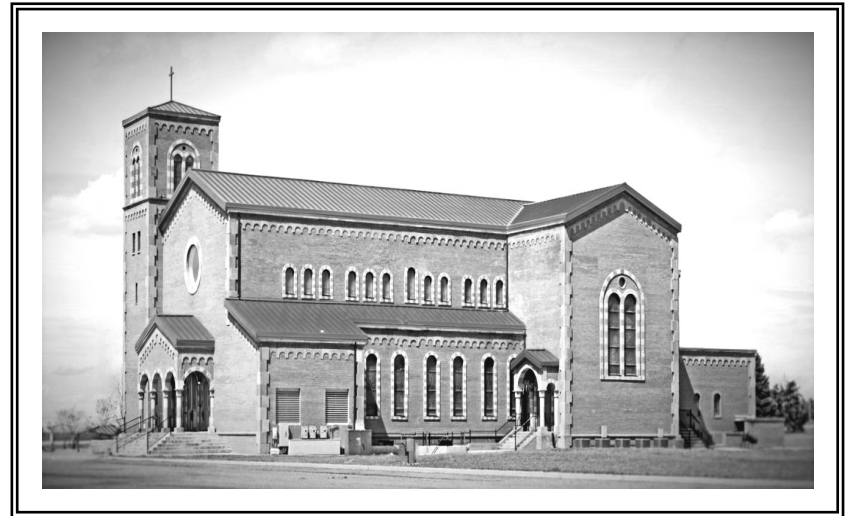
