

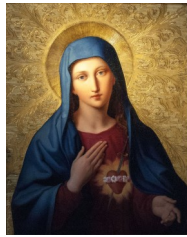
### History on the Mothers of Lu Prayer

The little village of Lu is located in northern Italy. It has only a few thousand inhabitants. In the year 1881, the family mothers of Lu, under the direction of their parish priest, would gather every Tuesday for the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, asking the Lord for vocations. They received Holy Communion on the first Sunday of every month with the same intention. After Mass, the mothers would say a particular prayer together imploring for vocations to the priesthood. From the tiny village of Lu came 323 vocations! There were 152 priest and 171 nuns! Every ten years, priests and Sisters born in Lu come together from all around the world for a reunion which is a true celebration of thanksgiving to God who has done such great things for Lu.

### *The Immaculate Heart of Mary*

Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is the natural outcome of the worship of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. From her pure heart our Divine Lord got His Precious Blood, and on the same heart He reposed His sacred head in the cave at Bethlehem and on the heights of Calvary.

This truth prompted St. Bernard to write: *“If affrighted by the heinousness of your sins, if confounded by the foul state of your conscience, if terrified by the fear of the judgment to come, you are sinking down into the depths of sadness, the abyss of despair, think of Mary.”*

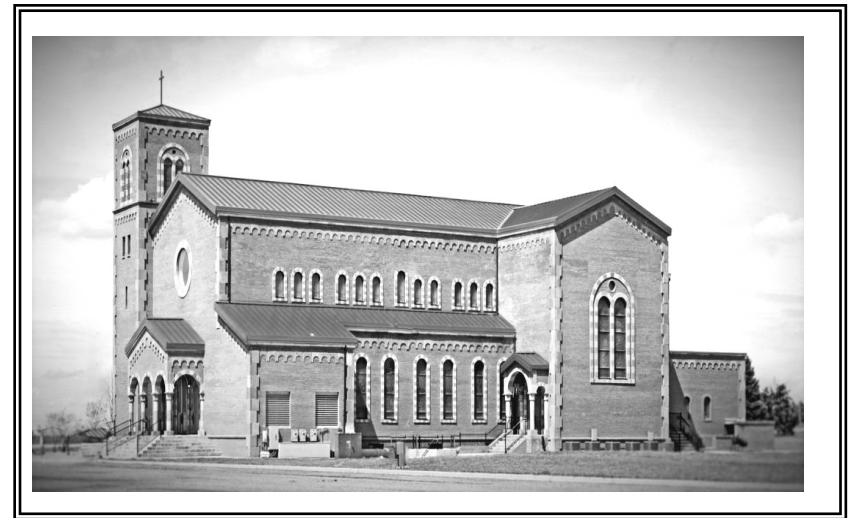
