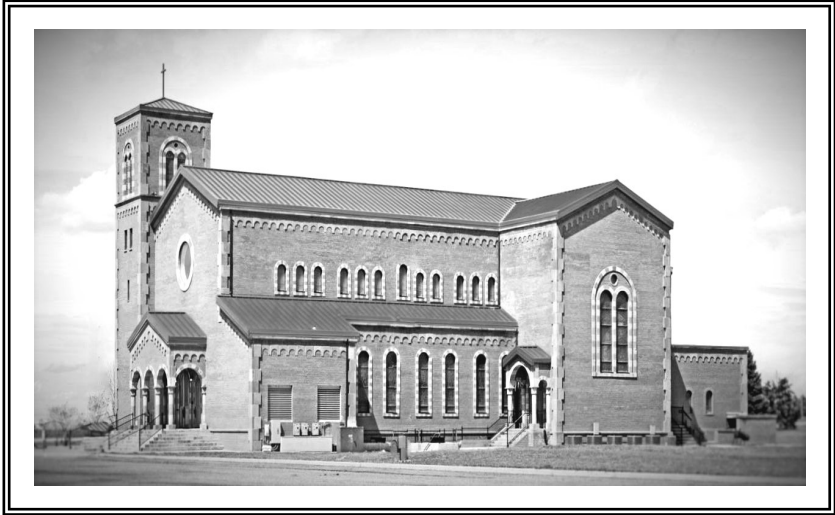

**Today: Fr. McManus Will Hear Confessions** through the Mass.

**Today: We will pray** the Mothers of Lu prayer after Mass.

**Today: Altar and Rosary** will meet after Mass. All the ladies of the parish are invited.

**Monday: School will resume**, following the priests' meeting break.

**Tuesday: A Day of Recollection** will take place for the Upper School.

**Wednesday: Ash Wednesday**, the beginning of Lent. It is an obligatory day of fast and of complete abstinence from meat. Traditionally, the fast days of Lent are Monday through Saturday from Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday. The 5:15 am Mass will be offered with the blessing of ashes. For the 8 am School Mass and the 7 pm evening Mass, ashes will be distributed before Mass. There will also be a 7 pm Mass at Annunciation Chapel in Fort Collins.

**Thursday: All Day Adoration** will begin after the 8 am School Mass. Reposition will be at 6:30 pm. A sign up sheet will be in the vestibule this week. The intentions are as follows: victory over the interior and exterior enemies of the Church, the return of Rome and the bishops to the Tradition of the Church and the Faith of our Fathers, the sanctification of priests and future candidates, and the blossoming of numerous priestly and religious vocations. Please make time to watch an hour with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

**Thursday: The school will kick off** its annual Jogathon at 2:30 pm.

**Friday: School will be dismissed** after the 11:30 am School Mass. Parent/Teacher conferences will take place before and after the 6:30 pm Stations.

**Friday: Stations of the Cross** will be prayed at **6:30 pm**. They will be held at 7 pm on all the other Fridays of Lent, except for First Friday on which they will be at 6:30.

**Saturday: Seminary professor Fr. Steve Reuter** will be visiting Saint Isidore's. He will give a day for high school and college boys, which will begin with 8 am Mass and will end with Benediction with Rosary. The end time will be determined by how many boys and young men sign up. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Please utilize the sign up sheet in the vestibule so we know how many to prepare for.

**Next Sunday: Fr. Reuter will give** a Seminary presentation and fundraiser after Mass. The Second Collection taken next Sunday will go towards Father's fundraising efforts. Please plan to stay to watch the presentation on vocations and update on the building of the Seminary in Virginia.
